I need a 2021 Membership Application from the office. I updated the Apprenticeship Application. The last time that I talked to Nick there were 36 applicants for the

clinic. Some are going to learn more about showing and others to earn judging certification.

I am very concerned about the wording of Item 1, #4 of the Performance Committee Report regarding exhibitors signing up for incorrect classes passed at the March meeting.. It is too open and could be interpreted to say that an exhibitor or animal would lose all awards ever earned if the exhibitor signed up for and exhibited in an incorrect Division. As a member of the Protest Committee and the Chair of the Judge's Committee I would have the responsibility of facilitating a protest regarding a rule that I consider to be unclear and unfair.

I request the Board to amend #4 to the following:

Item 1 and 4

Any animal shown in an inappropriate Division will have any placements, awards or titles earned from participation in that inappropriate Division removed.
