### I. Office Report:

ALSA November 2021 Office report

It has been requested that all youth performance results post the name of the animal that was used. I understand the basis for this request; however, our current database will not handle this reporting in an accurate way. It does not tie to the animal database with a drop-down list to pick up the animal information. It has also been my experience that one animal can be called by as many names as the number of shows that animal is entered into. So, just entering whatever name is used on the entry is really not solving this issue but has the potential to make it even worse.

IF the Board of Directors approve this change, the only way it will be effective is if just the ILR/AOA/ALSA number is entered without the name.

I spoke to Lauren last week for about an hour. An email she sent to me following our phone call is copied below with links. She had many excellent questions that I was able to answer or explain. She is asking for photos and videos. While we all agree that shows are an integral part of ALSA, I believe that also highlighting other aspects of alpaca/llama life is important: Fiber (shearing to processing to finished product), nursing home visits, school visits and education, commercial promotion, and general alpaca/llama keeping activities.

Naturally I asked what was in it for us....at the concept stage we can only talk generalities. The individuals who will participate are considered "talent" and are compensated. We also talked about the possibility of Production underwriting the costs of a show (Grand National? Oh, what a dream!). I think the biggest thing that ALSA would realize is grandly <u>increased visibility</u>. There *might* be monetary rewards to ALSA, but that is something that should be discussed.

Some of the guestions/issues/concerns/ideas I have thus far:

Idea-All "talent" wear ALSA logoed apparel

Concern-All "talent" would be strongly urged to have a lawyer review the contract prior to signing.

Question-Does ALSA have to have a disclaimer or waiver signed by "talent" holding ALSA harmless?

Indeed, this is just the very start of the process – making the decision to move on to the next step which is providing photos/videos. Personally, I have watched Lucky Dog productions and they are certainly not the type that Bravo (Real Housewives of.....) puts out. They are factual, educational, and entertaining! I believe that a fantastic gift has just landed in our laps, and we should not hesitate to investigate the possibilities further.
