I. Office Report:

The Office Manager reported that, due to the COVID-19 virus, there was not much activity going on. Linda said she had invested time in reviewing the Constant Contact communications list. She found there were numerous addresses to which messages were being sent at ALSA expense but had no affiliation any longer with ALSA. She has cleansed the list, which could result in a reduction in this expense going forward.

Another item of concern is that, suddenly, the database is not accessible. Her husband, an IT person, has not ben able to access it and they have contacted the server manager for his help. He is working on the problem, however with the COVID-19 virus problem in the area, his time is limited. Linda is preparing to solicit bids to restore/replace the database and will keep the Board informed as to that progress.

Motion: Pay the office expenses of \$113.00 for June, 2020. Motion by Carol. Seconded by Ron. Motion unanimously passed.

II. Treasurer's Report:

Vern pointed out to the Board it will have to decide regarding the database costs once bids for its restoration/replacement are received.

Very importantly in view of the current pandemic, ALSA basically is holding its own as regards its finances. While income is virtually non-existent with the lack of shows, new memberships, and other income sources, the tremendous reduction in office expenses has held the drain on cash resources down. Vern forecasted that, for the balance of 2020, the major expense will relate to the ongoing office activities and the Grand National Show, if it proceeds.

<u>Bylaws Ballot</u> - The Committee prepared the balloting platform for the Bylaws ballot. Voting began July 6 at noon Central Time. This information was communicated to the office.

The ballot ends July 12 at Noon. Results will be forwarded to the Election and Bylaw Committee Liaisons. After the Board is informed of the results, the results will be sent via a Simply Voting eblast to the Electors. The text for an e-Blast with the results will also be sent to the office for distribution.

<u>General Election</u> - Two seats are open for the new Board year, which begins January 1, 2021. The time for a member to submit their intention to run for the Board of Directors opened July 1 and will close September 1. The Judge's Committee has little to report this month.

One thing that is of concern: Judges who signed contracts early on the year prior to the tremendous spread of COVID 19. I am writing to ask the Board to allow Judges to be allowed to be released from their contracts if they have a concern about exposure to COVID 19 during travel to and from a show or during the time that they are judging a show. The Judge should inform the show Superintendent at least 30 days prior to the show or earlier if requesting a release from don contract without repercussions.

We need to be sensitive to the fact that many of our Judges are in the age group of most concern and have family members who are infirm.

I believe there will be a vaccine that should protect us next year. We need to protect everyone, so we have exhibitors and Judges for the following years. Cyndi Ernst, Chair

If a Judge feels the need to opt out of a judging assignment, that should be done no later than 45 days before the show is scheduled to start. It is noted that were it to be done within the 45 days, a possible ethics violation or protest could result.

- B. What regional shows are going to be held? At this time, the Southeastern Regional, Buckeye Regional and Western Regional shows are scheduled to proceed. Others are still under discussion in view of the COVID-19 situation.
- C. What should we send to Indiana State Fair/Lisa Robinson and Fort Wayne about not sanctioning with ALSA this year? Upon discussion, a letter will be sent to show management of these and some other events suggesting that future shows be dual shows with the ILR. The Board will review that letter before it is sent.
- D. What are we going to charge for membership for the remainder of the year? This matter received serious attention as the COVID-19 pandemic has tremendously impacted the livestock community this year, with shows and even state fairs already being cancelled. ALSA wants to keep its membership growing, with the expectation 2021 will result in a return to at least a semblance of normalcy. Having considered several options, the following Motion was adopted:

Motion: ALSA will offer a regular membership for the balance of 2020 and all of 2021 for \$70.00. Youth members will be offered a membership for 2020 and all of 2021 for \$35.00. Motion by Ron. Seconded by Deb. Motion unanimously passed. **E.** Carol asked about the 2020 Youth Scholarship awardees. The Board expressed its pleasure that these fine youth applied for the scholarships.
