The State Fair of Florida has sanctioned an ALSA show for 2012.

Shows that sanctioned for 2020, but were not held due to the pandemic and have not requested a return of their sanctioning fee, will be automatically sanctioned for 2021.

The fact that Linda is paying for matters dealing with the website personally was discussed. She will be reimbursed for this on a quarterly basis.

ALSA 2019 Handbook Addendum

Effective Date	Change
March 20, 2019	ALSA recommends that there be one lama for one youth, but the show superintendent may allow two youth to use the same lama but in different age divisions. In no case may more than two youth use the same lama.
July 8, 2019	Per July 8, 2019 BOD Minutes, the minimum age for Junior Youth has been lowered to 7 years of age. This rule change applies to all shows held after that date.
November 13, 2019	Per November 13, 2019 BOD Minutes, the maximum age for Senior Youth has been raised to 19 years of age. This rule change applies to all shows held after that date.
January 1, 2020	Per February 12, 2020 BOD Minutes, as of January 1, 2020, unregistered animals are required to have an ALSA tracking number to be shown in Youth, performance, or Adult Non-breeder classes. ALSA will no longer charge for an animal to have an ALSA number to show and for points to be accumulated.
	Animals will be tracked for show purposes and points accumulation using one of the following numbers:
	 ALSA assigned "1XXXXXXXX" number (purchased prior to 1/1/2020)
	 ILR number (registered with ALSA after 1/1/2020) AOA number (registered with ALSA after 1/1/2020) ALSA assigned "NAxxx" number

Tabled from October:

The Judge's Committee would like to Board to seriously consider sanctioning participation in the Eastern Iowa Llama Judging Clinic in Central City, Iowa, May 14-16, 2021. And, waive the current Handbook requirements for Instructors for Cathie Kindler, Mike Haumschild and Tor Sorensen for the clinic, allowing them to be the ALSA Instructors.

We were contacted by ILR Judge's Committee Chair, Nick Hauptly to see if ALSA would have interest participating in the Eastern Iowa Llama Judging Clinic. Joining forces would allow both associations to gather enough participants to hold a clinic and, more important, help new Judges understand the differences that they would encounter Judging combined ALSA/ILR shows.

The Committee members reviewed the training plan to find it very comprehensive (See attached) with the use of face-to-face and virtual communication tools. Nick is a teacher. His training came to light as he created the training plan. The face-to-face instructors are well respected, seasoned ALSA and ILR Judges, Cathie Kindler, Tor Sorensen, and Mike Haumschild. The virtual guest presenters with in-depth knowledge are to be announced at a later date.

The problem that we encounter as we review the Handbook before presenting the clinic to the Board is, none of the instructors are certified ALSA Instructors, but probably should be. They definitely have Instructor experience because they all have mentored numerous ALSA Apprentice Judges. They definitely have in-depth- knowledge from years of consistent, successful Judging experience. In the last five years Cathie judged 15 shows, Mike judged 14 shows and Tor 13.

The rules follow:

Part S, Section 5, B. The Judge's Committee makes recommendations to the Board of Directors for Instructors and Assistant Instructors.

- 1. An Instructor must be a member in good standing, an ALSA certified Apprentice-Accepting Llama, Alpaca or Fleece Judge and have prior instructor experience. To be placed on the recommendation list, an Instructor must first successfully complete at least two (2) approved ALSA Judging Clinics as an Assistant Instructor in their chosen discipline, with a favorable evaluation from the Instructor and Board approval. All instruction materials must be approved by the Judge's Committee.
- 2. If a person has depth of knowledge and previous instructing experience, he/she may apply, in writing, to the Judge's Committee for a waiver of a portion of the instructor's training requirements. Any waiver must be approved by the ALSA Board of Directors.

Motion: Approve participation in the Eastern Iowa Llama Judging Clinic in Central City, Iowa, May 14-16, 2021, waiving the Handbook instructor requirements for Cathie Kindler, Mike Haumschild and Tor Sorensen allowing them to be the ALSA Instructors for the clinic. Motion by Ron. Seconded by Carol. Motion Unanimously passed.

Regarding the subject of instituting a silky class, the following suggestion was presented by the Judges' Committee:

The silky halter division is based on fiber type just like suri. Light, Medium, and Heavy halter divisions are based on fiber coverage. In considering that, EVERY silky animal would also fit in light, medium or heavy divisions.

A silky halter division is viable. To add the division would be fine and certainly would make the combination of ALSA and ILR-SD shows much easier. It would be advisable, if we add the Silky halter division, to make it an optional, not required class, as if it was a required division, it would require shows to purchase additional awards and show time-some of which they couldn't afford. All agreed that the Performance Committee should revisit this topic, holding further discussion, and Anna will provide an updated report during the December board meeting.
