- B. Such other business as may come before the Board.
 What to do about a 2020 Annual Meeting was explored at length. One suggestion was to hold a Zoom meeting so that members could attend in virtual person. To maintain continuity during such a meeting, a moderator would be required to turn on and off microphones in an orderly fashion. Another thought was to determine if, considering the pandemic, Wisconsin (where ALSA is incorporated) would waive the requirement of an annual meeting. Ron will follow up on this. If the plan is to proceed with an annual meeting, it will be held the same weekend as Grand National was planned.

The next regular Board meeting will be October 14, 2020 at 7:00 p.m. CDT.
