

The Happy Hippy Llama Show Rules

Spring is bringing out all the Happy Hippies! Pull out your hippie attire and spring flowers, and head out to Chicopee Woods Agricultural Center in Gainesville, Georgia to enjoy some llama and alpaca fun and fellowship! It will be a great opportunity to showcase your herd, show off your llama and alpaca spirit and your skills.

Something fun: It's competition challenges. We will be looking for our Best Happy Hippy Team (Handler and Ilama/alpaca team) who shows the Happiest Hippy attire and spirit, and one for most decorated Happy Hippy stall. Prizes and bragging rights will be awarded!

Friday night, April 11, 2025, will be our "Potluck" dinner at 6 p.m. Please let Kim Kyst know what you will be contributing to the shared Potluck dinner. <u>kim@kyst.org</u> Southeast Show Team will be providing all the paper products, plasticware, teas and ice.



The show will be held at the Chicopee Agricultural Center located at 1855 Calvary Church Road, Gainesville, Georgia in Arena A.

The base date for computing the animal's age is April 11, 2025.

Entry fee is \$76 per llama. This includes ALSA/ILR-SD recording fees. Fees for the group classes are \$16 per entry.

We are trying to work out offering hay and straw. Supplies have been really limited in the Georgia area. We are still trying to locate a hay and straw supplier. We will let you know if we have hay and straw available, soon.

Complete entry forms, fees, copies of registration papers or ILR numbers, and 2025 ALSA card must be included in your show entry package. Package must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2025. Failure to send an ILR number or a copy of registration papers prohibits entry in this show. Late entries will be accepted until April 11,2025; however, a \$10 per animal fee is required.

If you don't own the llama, you must have an ALSA permission to show form. The permission to show form can be found on the ALSA website.

All exhibitors must be a current member of ILR and ALSA. Please provide a copy of your 2025 ALSA Membership card.

Each youth will be allowed one youth llama at the price of \$60. This enters the llama in all youth performance classes and youth showmanship. If the animal is going to be in halter the \$76 fee is required.

We will make an attempt to run pleasure driving, obstacle driving, youth ground driving, and adult ground driving classes Friday night.

The Judges Meeting will be at 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning in Arena D. We will follow show book order throughout the show weekend.

Stall cost is \$36 for either llamas or tack.

Hay and Straw will be available through pre-ordering for this show. Please pre-order with Kathy Devaul at 229-347-1698, kdevaul2@gmail.com, or on your entry forms.

- Bermuda Hay will be \$13.99 a bale
- Straw will be \$10.99 a bale

Performance awards will be given out during the catered breakfast Sunday morning. The cost per person is \$17 for breakfast. Breakfast will be at 7:30 a.m. Sunday, April 13th in the Activity Hall at the Chicopee Agricultural Center.

The show will be governed by the current ALSA handbook unless site rules are enforced.

Llamas/Alpacas must have a health certificate signed by a vet dated within 30 days and stating Happy Hippy Llama Show, Gainesville, Georgia as the destination.

Check-in will begin Friday, April 11th, 2025, from 9:00 a.m.- 6 p.m. Please check in with the show clerk for your stall assignments. Show clerk will be set up in Arena D. All stalls are preassigned by the show superintendent. (Stalling preferences are given to show sponsors and volunteers.) You will receive your show packet at this time. Don't forget your Health Certificates! You may check in on Thursday, however, you MUST make prior arrangements with the show superintendent-Kathy Devaul.

Bring on your Hippy Attire! The handler's attire should be conservative, neat and appropriate for the class. Shoes should be appropriate for the show ring and must completely cover the foot. Inappropriate footwear will disqualify the exhibitor, who will be dismissed from the show ring immediately.

According to ALSA guidelines: It is Show Management's responsibility to dismiss an exhibitor or spectator who is abusive or who demonstrates bad sportsmanship toward the Judge, Show Personnel, or any other exhibitor.

This show is designed to be a fun, easy, enjoyable experience with lots of Happy Hippies.

All dogs MUST be on a leash and behave appropriately. A dog's waste must be cleaned up immediately and appropriately disposed of, this is the responsibility of the owner.

All llamas on the premises must meet health requirements and be entered in the show.

Class placement ribbons, Overall Performance Awards and one Judge's Choice Award will be awarded per judge.

Non ILR registered llamas or llamas without an ILR listing number may show in the Performance, Showmanship, Youth division or other optional classes ONLY after obtaining an ILR tracking number. There will be an annual fee of \$10.00 for this tracking number.

All youth ages are determined as of January 1, except for 8-year-old who are considered 8 as of their birthday. If a youth shows in an adult showmanship class, they are no longer eligible to show in the youth showmanship classes. The youth classes may be combined as seen fit by the superintendents.

Youth Classes are for the youth. Youth may exhibit only one entry per Youth class. The same animal shall NOT be entered in 2 different performance divisions.

Entries in performance classes are restricted in that an animal may be entered in the Youth classes OR the non-youth classes (novice, advanced, and masters) but not both.

Health Requirements

In state and out of state animals:

All llamas must have a certificate of veterinary inspection issued within 30 days of the show. The certificate must show the animal's name, sex, registration number, color, and permanent identification (tattoo, microchip, or USDA ear tag) if any. If a microchip is used, the owner must provide a reader, if needed. The Georgia Department of Agriculture has waived all brucellosis and tuberculosis testing for llamas and alpacas that are exhibited in Georgia. *If animals are to remain in state from out of state, a negative brucellosis test is needed.

NOTE

<u>Health certificate for in state and out of state animals must state intact males have 2 normal</u> <u>testicles: breeding females have normal external organs: or confirmation of non-breeder</u> <u>statues.</u>

Motor Homes

Motor Home accommodation with hook ups are limited. They will be reserved on a first come first serve basis until all spaces are filled. Motor Home hook up can be reserved by contacting Kathy Devaul and include your RV fees on your Entry Form.

Vendor Information

Calling all vendors. We would like to encourage vendors to set up and market their wares and services. Vendors will need to reserve a space on your Entry Form. The fee is \$30 for a 12' X 12' space inside Arena D near the hospitality area. Vendors must provide their own tables and tent, if needed.
