

Rocky Mountain Pasture Show Double ALSA Halter Show, Single Performance 2Bit2 Ranch, Florissant, CO Marcie Saska Agnew July 11-July 13, 2025 Judges: Ana Reese Tor Sorensen

The Rocky Mountain Pasture Show will be a single performance, double halter points ALSA Show with confirmed judges: Tor Sorensen and Ana Reese.

- General Information Overview: Check-in Friday July 11 at 2Bit2 Ranch in Florissant, CO near Eleven Mile Reservoir. Performance on Saturday (July 12) with Halter on Sunday (July 13). Camping is rustic; no hook ups, no internet. There will be a porta potty, food truck (Margaret's Munchies), along with a pot luck dinner on Saturday night. We will provide the main meat dish and just ask that everyone bring a side or salad to share. We'll have a few extra water/sports drinks but folks need to bring their own beverages and food since we are fairly remote. Make sure to pack artificial shade and extra sunscreen so you can unplug for the weekend and enjoy the beautiful scenery, cooler temps, and all your llama friends! Dogs will be allowed in the camping area. Thank you!!!!
- **These shows are sanctioned** by Alpaca and Llama Show Associations Inc. (ALSA). The shows will run according to rules/guidelines in the ALSA 23rd edition Handbook. Visit <u>www.alsashow.org</u> to review complete ALSA handbook. Your ALSA membership number and all ALSA Llama numbers must be on the registration for accurate reporting to ALSA.
- All llamas and alpacas 5 months and older are eligible to participate. All animals must be registered with the ILR for Halter classes. You may obtain more information on ALSA membership and/or an ALSA llama membership number by contacting the ALSA office at 281-516-1442. All llamas entered in approved classes, with the exception of youth classes, must be registered or have passed screening with the International Llama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). Alpacas must be registered by the Alpaca Owners Association (AOA), Alpaca Registry Inc. (ARI) or by the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC).

If non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in the ALSA award system and wish to show in halter, they must show in the Adult Non-Breeder Halter Class.

Registrations must include ALSA member number, or Youth ALSA number. Copies of pending registration must be presented at check-in. Exhibitors must be registered owners and must make entries in the exact names (owner and animal) as shown on the Ilama's ILR registration certificate. A photocopy of the registration papers must be uploaded with the entry form for each breeding Ilama.

Exhibitor/owners may use the" Permission to Show" form provided by ALSA which grants permission from the owner named on the registration certificate to a person who is using an animal to show under their name. Failure to meet these requirements prohibits entry in the show.

Deadline: June 25, 2025.

Nonbreeder llamas must be accompanied by registration of a vet certificate verifying the llama is a gelding, a vasectomized male, or a spayed or non-productive female. Nursing llama mothers may NOT be accompanied in the ring by their babies. ALSA recommends not showing nursing mothers.

Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at the judge's discretion.

Youth Age Divisions Youth age as of Jan. 1, of current year Sub junior - 4 thru 6 yrs Youth Junior *-7 thru 11 yrs. 7 yr olds may show as of their birthday

Youth Intermediate - 12 thru 14 yrs

Youth Senior – 15 thru 19 yrs.**

*Juniors may not show intact male llamas age 18 months or older

** When a senior youth reaches their 20th birthday before the show they are no longer eligible to show in the youth division at all

Halter Classes: Animal's age as of the first day of the show

Juvenile – 5 months through 12 months Yearling – 12 months through 24 months Two Year Old – 204 months through 36 months Adult – 36 months and older

Llama wool description and group classes Please enter your llamas in the appropriate wool divisions as outlined below. No wool class changes made at the show except by the judges

- a) Suri Lustrous, cool hand, lack of crimp and minimal loft, locked fiber that drapes over the llama's body.
- b) Silky Very soft or silky handle, may be straight or have some wave or crinkle but not crimp
- c) Classic Abundant guard hair visible on the body and neck of the animal, with short and minimal "downy" undercoat, Minimal Fleece on legs/head
- d) Light Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth legs.
- e) Medium Moderate to long body wool, minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate and leg wool.
- f) Heavy Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool. (leg wool at least to knee and hock).
- g) Non-Breeder Llama that cannot be used for breeding purposes, usually due to being spayed, vasectomized, or a gelding.
- h) Judges have the right to combine classes based on entry count.

Performance Classes: Handlers may enter five animals. An animal can only go through a course one time, Youth, Novice, Advanced or Master. Youth may exhibit only one entry per youth class. To qualify for Youth Performance Champion, the youth must show in Obstacle, PR, and Pack and MUST USE THE SAME ANIMAL in all three classes.

Youth may show in either the Youth Performance Classes OR Novice, Advanced, or Master's Performance, but not in both unless different llamas are used. Points earned in the Youth Classes are awarded to the youth, whereas points in Novice, Advance, and Master's Performance are awarded to the llama.

Halter: \$30 (Dual Show)

Performance/Youth: \$15 per class (Single Show)

Special Youth Flat Rate Option: \$35 per youth exhibitor for both shows. Enter as many youth classes as you like, does not include halter.

Flat Rate Option for All Halter and Performance: \$50 per llama entered for both shows. Enter as many classes as you like for each llama entered.

ALSA fees: \$10 per llama/alpaca in dual show. Non-Member fee is \$50. ALSA Youth non-member fee is \$15.

THERE ARE NO STALLS: Please bring panels or material to coral your animals (Just like at previous Pasture Shows).
