The Alpaca Llama Show Association (ALSA) is proud to support our outstanding youth members as they pursue higher education. The ALSA Youth Scholarship Fund will now operate on a **tiered award structure**:

- 1–5 eligible applications received: ONE (1) scholarship of \$1,000 will be awarded.
- **6 or more eligible applications received**: TWO (2) scholarships of \$750 each will be awarded.

Eligibility Criteria

To qualify for the ALSA Youth Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a current ALSA Youth Member in good standing.
- Be a **High School Senior**, graduating in the year of application.
- Be no older than 19 years of age at the time of application.
- Plan to attend a **Higher Education Accredited Institution** within **one year** of applying.

Application Deadline

 - o One from an individual in your educational background
 - o One from someone familiar with your **llama or alpaca-related involvement**
 - o Relatives are not permitted as recommenders

ALSA Youth Judging Selection Committee Selection Criteria

To ensure fair and consistent evaluation, the committee will use the following criteria:

Evaluation Category	Maximum Points
Completion & Organization of Application	10 points
Academic Achievement & Goals	15 points
Leadership & Extracurricular Involvement	15 points
Community Service	10 points
ALSA/Llama Involvement & Impact	20 points
Recommendation Letters	10 points
Clarity and Thoughtfulness of Essay Responses	20 points
TOTAL	100 points

Bonus: An additional 5 bonus points may be awarded for attending and participating in ALSA-sanctioned events during the application year, including the Grand National Championship.
